With release of 'TILL IRELAND A NATION, their fifth 1rish-produced album, the WOLFE TONES celebrate their eleventh year as a folk group.

Starting in their teens by playing at the Fleadh Ceoils, these four young men soon graduated into a full professional career, taking their name from one of Ireland's great martyred heroes, Theobald Wolfe Tone.

Their exhuberant love of Irish music and the enthusiasm they bring to each performance continues to pervade their balladry. In their years as Ireland's top folk group, the WOLFE TONES have added a greater depth to their talents, achieving a well-deserved recognition in ballad room sessions, on concert stage and television both in America and on the Continent as well as at home.

Always willing to perform the folk music of other countries and to add new songs to their repertoire, they still draw the bulk of their material from Ireland's rich musical heritage. In this, they reflect the long history of the Irish rebellions against oppression and the sorrows of the large emigrations of her people as well as the wit and humour for which the Irish are known.
